Pricing Examples "Using Quick Quote Method "Practice Quote & email yourself"

Age 30 male / Skilled Trade Class / 30 day wait – 2 year benefit -\$1,000 per mo. - Cost \$23.00 per mo.

Age 30 male / Phys Labor or Trucker / 60 day wait – 2 year benefit - \$1,000 per mo. - Cost \$36.00 per mo.

Age 30 Female / Skilled Trade Class / 30 day wait = 2 year benefit - \$1,000 per mo. - Cost \$29.00 per mo.

Causes of Disability – "There are more causes than this –listing some major ones."

Work place accidents – depending on occupation, ranges **between 1 and 5 per 100 workers annually** Office is a 1 and trades and truckers are closer to 5.
